Agenda:

- 1) Nurse Bluhm announced that the school board approved the resolutions for SHAC to convene and discuss curriculum materials for human sexuality instruction, prevention of child abuse, family violence, dating violence and sex trafficking.
- 2) Senate bill 9- information with presentations per zoom- a) Tiffany Ekpete-BASE b) Play it Safe- Diane Mayfield
- 3) House bill- 1525-Human sexuality instruction material- Big Decisions (Kenedy ISD has in place) and SHARE (Floresville ISD has in place). Nurse Bluhm will contact Kenedy nurse and is in contact with Floresville Nurse
- 4) Health and safe school Environment- a) end of COVID pandemic- Nurse Bluhm reports with the pandemic declared over on May 11, no more testing is being provided in the blue building b) Todd Espinoza discussed safety trainings including heat training and other safety postings, including human trafficking postings; working with city and TxDOT about crosswalks and school zones. Amanda asked about cameras at the track, Todd is working on it c) Narcan discussion- Nurse Bluhm will meet with Superintendent d) safety concerns- Primary playground etc. Nurse Bluhm talked to Todd about the wood chips and causing minor injuries. Todd and Alan are looking into it.

- 6) Staff/student/parent wellness activities- Nurse Bluhm reporting for RES- did a weight loss challenge- 9 participants- each put \$50.00. Amanda Osuna won the challenge. Also discussed "It's Time Texas" and "Walk Across Texas" wellness activities for school district next year.

- 7) School Health Coordinated program- CATCH program, Nurse Bluhm states that the program was the last one used before COVID.
- 8) Open discussion for other school health concerns- Rita asking about additional SRO hiring and Guardian program. Amanda inquiring if the present SROs will be available during the summer on the campuses. Megan Martinez RN presented on being the Wesley Nurse for the Methodist church and services that she is able to provide. Flyers will be posted.
