Otto Kaiser Memorial Hospital's Vaccine Team has been safely vaccinating the residents of Karnes County since January of this year. Now that the vaccine has been approved under the EUA for ages 12 and up, we are offering it to students in local school districts whose parents may be interested in getting their children vaccinated. Besides this KCISD Clinic, you may also get the vaccine on our Hospital Campus, at the Bonnstetter Building on May 26th or June 2nd from 1-7 pm. Why do you need a vaccine? The CDC recommends that everyone 12 years and older should get a COVID-19 vaccination to help protect against COVID-19. Widespread vaccination is a critical tool to help stop the pandemic. Getting your child or teen vaccinated can bring you one step closer to enjoying the activities you miss.

Parents who decide to have their children vaccinated will need to either attend the clinic with their child to fill out the Pre-vaccination Forms or pick up and return the Vaccine Forms to the school prior to the clinic time. Vaccine Forms may be picked up at the Front Office of any of our school campuses. **Important:** The CDC recommends that students should not receive any other vaccine 2 weeks prior to, or 2 weeks after their COVID Vaccine.
