Stakeholder/Public Comment Process

Karnes City ISD's stakeholder engagement process involves in-person meetings and surveys. The initial survey was available on the KCISD website for an extended amount of time for all community members, including staff and students an opportunity to participate. KCISD ensured all statutorily required stakeholders were/are represented throughout the process. The survey included questions to rank importance, while also providing open-ended responses. The in-person meetings include presentations of data and provide opportunities for all in attendance to provide feedback.
