Library Calculator – Checkout Responsibilities

Your son/daughter will be issued a graphing calculator to be used in Geometry/Algebra class, if a personal **graphing** calculator is not owned. Since calculator use is essential for the testing, the graphing calculator is being issued in a similar manner to a textbook.

It is the student's responsibility to take care of the calculator and replace batteries as needed. If the calculator is lost, stolen or damaged in any way it is the student and parent's responsibility to pay for it. Replacement cost for TI-83 Plus is \$90.00. Replacement cost for TI-84 CE Plus is \$133.00.

Since the KCHS calculators are used on ALL standardized tests, it is your child's responsibility to return the calculator to the library as needed to avoid disciplinary action as determined by administration. If you choose to purchase a calculator for your child, the calculator that will be used will be the TI-84. This is the calculator your child will be given to use during the STAAR EOC test. **Please note that your child may NOT** use his/her own calculator during the EOC testing.

In the past, we have had problems with calculators being returned without the bar code. Each calculator has a unique code that can be used to find out specific information about the item. Removing a bar code will be considered as damage, and the cost of replacing it will be added to the student's account (\$2.00 per barcode). The replacement cost of the following calculator parts is as follows: Slide Cover Replacement: \$4.95; Battery Cover Replacement: \$1.95
