What to expect in this week's packet?

### Reading-

### Math-

- Complete the 9 review questions.
- Enrichment practice sheets have been included for additional practice.

### Science-

- Complete unfinished work from last week's packet.
- Read the Air pressure passage and complete the questions that follow.
- Use information from packet to complete a 5-question weather assessment.

### Social Studies-

- Enjoy exploring Texas history by reading and answering the questions from the Chapter 6 pages that were provided in the packet.

### Language Arts & Writing-

- A cursive chart and lined paper have been placed in a protective sleeve, so students may practice their handwriting daily with a dry erase marker by tracing the alphabet on one side, and then practice writing sentences on the opposite side. A dry erase marker has been included in each packet.
- In addition, a 3-week daily writing activity choice sheet has been included. Over the next few weeks, students will choose which writing activity they will complete on Monday - Friday. After completion of their daily task, students should read over their writing with a parent or guardian who will then sign off in that box on the chart. Notebook paper and pencils have been provided in the packet as well. Enjoy expressing your creative ideas, thoughts, and topics through writing!
